PROJECT NEWS HIGHLIGHTS

KC's New York City and Circleville offices worked together with Stantec and Advanced Storage Technology (AST) on a *Salt Storage Building* in Hauppauge, Long Island for the NYSDOT this quarter. This project was to develop a 104 foot x 70 foot salt storage shed capable of storing up to 3,000 cubic yard of salt. KC's NYC office performed all of the site development while KC's Circleville office worked closely with the architect, designed the electrical system, and wrote the specifications for the project. The project was closely reviewed by the New York State Office of General Services to ensure it met all aspects of the International Building Code. The project had an accelerated schedule requiring it to be completed by the end of November so that the salt storage building could be used this winter. The project design was started in mid-July and by mid-December, salt was being stored in the shed.



KC was retained to provide *Supplemental Traffic Studies* for the various projects at the Montreign Casino. KC has provided the Montreign Casino project with construction inspection and SWPPP inspection services.

Another project that KC began this quarter is work on the *Emergency Shelter and Community Center* project in the Village of Ellenville, which is a project funded through the NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program of the Governor's Office of Storm Recovery. This project will provide the Village with a local shelter that will provide a resilient and safe location within the area for members of the community. During non-emergency situations, the building will provide recreational, health, and educational program space for the entire community, and serve as a venue for public meetings and civil participation opportunities.



PROJECT NEWS HIGHLIGHTS

The design phase for the \$875,000 Village of Wappingers Falls *TAP Pedestrian Improvements* project continues with collaboration of KC Poughkeepsie and New York City staff. The project features curb bumpouts, crosswalks, and pedestrian safety lighting on Route 9D in the Village commercial district. A revised Engineer Report and detailed design plans have been submitted to NYSDOT. KC has identified LED pedestrian lighting that can serve as both pedestrian and street lights, allowing the Village to begin phasing out aged and costly cobra head street lights leased from the local utility. A public meeting was completed in November. Detailed design, bidding, and construction remain targeted for 2017.

In December, the Village of Wappingers Falls was awarded a \$925,000 *Water Quality Improvement Project (WQIP) Grant* for storm water quality improvements in response to a technical application prepared by the Village with assistance from KC. The grant award will allow the Village to advance additional improvements within a sequence of proposed improvements proposed for water quality improvements in the Wappinger Lake watershed.

KC has also begun work on the DCWWA's *Valley Dale Sewer Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehabilitation* project. The temporary plant is going online to bypass sewage until the rehabilitation is completed in January. KC is performing construction administration and inspection services.


Proposal for Engineering, Design, and Related Consultant Services for Lower Concourse Infrastructure
