




KC NEW YORK CITY

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

NYSDOT KEW GARDENS INTERCHANGE DESIGN-BUILD

This design-build project was chosen as the Engineering News-Record (ENR) New York Best Project Highway/Bridge for 2023. It was also awarded the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Best Use of Technology & Innovation Award, Large Project for 2023.

The scope of work for this New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) design-build project included the complete replacement of six bridge structures, which required demolition of the existing structures and complete construction of the replacement bridges. Additionally, the construction of five new bridges and alignment modifications provided operational improvements to the Grand Central Parkway, Jackie Robinson Parkway, and Union Turnpike in the Kew Gardens Interchange. The scope of highway work included realignment of the existing mainline roadways and interconnecting ramps within the Interchange.

KC served as an integral member of the design-build team, providing quality management and design services as Quality Manager and design partner, respectively. As an ISO 9001 certified consultant, we employed our robust knowledge of quality management practices to ensure that the design-build project was performed in accordance with project requirements and quality standards. Additionally, KC's knowledgeable team of professionals contributed to critical design components, including structural, utility, and environmental elements.




NYCEDC EAST MIDTOWN GREENWAY

On December 19, 2023, the ribbon-cutting ceremony for this project took place.

The East Midtown Greenway (EMG) is the second phase of a three phase development entitled the East Midtown Waterfront Project (EMWP). The intent of the EMWP is to construct a continuous public waterfront esplanade over the East River in Manhattan, NY. The project also includes a new pedestrian bridge that provides access to the esplanade at 54th Street and Sutton Place South.

KC performed the topographic survey, utility survey, and easement survey for the project. KC also researched available design drawings, as-built drawings, and aerial maps spanning approximately 80 years to understand site conditions, both above and below ground. KC assisted in providing an existing conditions report.

In addition, KC actively coordinated with the New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) and a bridge architectural firm to provide a bridge design that is visually appealing, meets the high expectations of the community, and adheres to design standards. The primary structure is a steel tied arch bridge with one arch on either side of the walkway. These arches have a rise of 18 feet, and are inclined 6 degrees outward. The walkway is a concrete deck with a clear width of 14 feet between railings. Lighting fixtures are mounted directly onto the arches to provide ample lighting onto the bridge deck. ϕ



NEW PROJECTS

NEW AWARD: Contract D006085: Professional Engineering Design Services for Upstate Capital Districts, New York State Office of Parks, Recreation & Historic Preservation (NYSOPRHP): KC, as subconsultant, will be providing civil engineering and surveying services for this project. The scope of work for this project includes providing project schematics (including project renderings), project design, phase studies, investigations, assessments, reports, and related services in support of the Capital program for facilities in the Allegany, Central, Genesee, Finger Lakes, Niagara, Palisades, Saratoga / Capital District, Taconic, and Thousand Islands State Park Regions.

NEW AWARD: Contract D038335: Desian Services Under Term Agreement for Signal, Lighting, and ITS Design - Downstate Regions 8, 10, and 11, New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT): The scope of work for this project involves services related to detailed design (Phases V-VI) for traffic signals, lighting, and intelligent transportation systems (ITS). KC, as subconsultant, will lead the survey team for this project.

NEW AWARD: Expert Professional Services for the Performance of a Condition Survey of Buildings 42, 43, 45, 46, 49, 53, 58, 76, 82, 87, 94, 106, 113, 115, and 130 at Newark Liberty International Airport, Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (PANYNJ): For this project, KC will provide visual and hands-on inspections of various structures at Newark Liberty International Airport, which will determine the overall condition of the structures and identify structural and non-structural deficiencies, if any, which may present a potential safety hazard. All inspection work and reports shall conform to the requirement of the PANYNJ


Quality Assurance Guidelines for Condition Survey of Buildings. KC is the prime consultant for this project.

NEW AWARD: Expert Professional Services for the Performance of a Condition Survey of Buildings 48, 55, 56, 101, 102, 103, and 154 at Newark Liberty International Airport, PANYNJ: Similar to the above project that KC was awarded, KC will provide visual and hands-on inspections of various structures at Newark Liberty International Airport as prime consultant, which will determine the overall condition of the structures and identify structural and non-structural deficiencies, if any, which may present a potential safety hazard.

NEW AWARD: Expert Professional Services for the Performance of a Condition Survey of Buildings 68, 8P, 9P, and 11P at Port Authority - Brooklyn Piers, New York Marine Terminal (NYMT), PANYNJ: KC, as prime consultant, was awarded this project to inspect suspended ceilings and soffits at various buildings at the NYMT. These inspections will include the measurement and documentation of each ceiling suspension component and the spacing of each component to permit a comparison to the PANYNJ's ceiling design and evaluation criteria.

NEW AWARD: Contract D041143: Term Agreement for Survey Services (TASS), Region 11, NYSDOT: KC will be providing survey services in New York City for this term agreement as the prime consultant.

RENEWED AWARD: Town of Milan Engineering Services 2024: The Town of Milan chose to renew their agreement with KC to provide engineering services throughout 2024. ϕ
